6TH Grade Math

- 3 spiral notebooks – single subject, 70-100 pages, these can be labeled Bell Work, Geometry, Number Systems
- 2 folders – if they match 2 of the folders...Geometry and Number Systems, bell work will not need a folder
- Pencils- many, many pencils
- Colored pencils
- Pencil sharpener

Important information:

- Pens will never be used in math class!
- Students will need 5-7 spiral notebooks for the entire year. Each content requirement will need their own.
- Bell Work and Number Systems will need more than 1 (however, only 1 is needed to start the year). The other topics include Geometry (needed for the start), Statistics and Probability, Ratio and Proportion and Expressions and Equations. Students may find it helpful to have a separate folder to coordinate with each spiral notebook.
