

The teachers of Bryant Middle School will be chaperoning our annual field trip to Cedar Point in Sandusky, Ohio on Wednesday, June 13, 2018.

Students who hope to attend will...

- Have good attendance. Students with excessive tardiness and absences or truancy in progress will not be permitted to go.
- Turn in their completed permission slip with \$75 CASH payment on time (last payment date is Wednesday, March 28th) ****No Refund****. There are 210 spots available for this trip. Tickets will be sold on a first come, first served basis.
- Have cleared all of their school fines and fees (classroom, textbook and library) by Friday, June 2nd.
- Passing **ALL** of their classes on June 9th.
- Any student assigned 3 or more detentions (including responsibility class) after March 19, 2018 will forfeit his/ her opportunity to attend and the money paid.
- Any student receiving a suspension after March 19th or having multiple suspensions (3 or more) will be excluded from the trip.

We, the staff at Bryant Middle School, take the safety of your child very seriously. Therefore, the cooperation of your child is required for student safety and the success of the trip. We expect all behaviors will be within the guidelines expressed in our "student code of conduct". Though your child will be chaperoned by a Bryant teacher or staff member, your child will be on his/her own (with other Bryant students) for most of the day. For this reason, we want your child to have a timepiece (watch or cell phone with a clock) so that they will be on time for their "mid-day check-in" with their chaperone and the departure from the park at the end of the day. Carrying a cell phone is perfectly acceptable and even recommended.

As a parent, we expect that the information that you place on the permission slip is complete and accurate. Also, please make sure that you are on time at the end of the day to pick up your child. Please carpool if you can. This will make for a safer start and end to the field trip. Please understand that failure to meet the expectations required to attend the trip will result in forfeiture of any money paid.

PTA Sponsored 8th grade Cedar Point Trip Wednesday, June 13, 2018

Traditionally, the 8th grade class at Bryant Middle School spends the day at Cedar Point at the end of the year. This year, we have reserved 4 buses for this trip. Tickets for this trip will be available on a first come, first served basis and are limited to Bryant 8th grade students ONLY.

There will be two Bryant staff members on each bus to chaperone this trip. We will be accepting parent chaperones. Those chaperones may get a free bus seat depending the student count and will purchase their park ticket through our group at \$ 39.00. Chaperones will need to be available for a 2-hour period to man our command post at the park (picnic area).

This is a Bryant Middle School sponsored event. Students on this trip will be held to high standards. Students who fail to follow the student code of conduct risk the privileges of attending the Honors Assembly. No horseplay or improper behavior will be tolerated on the bus or at the park. Any student(s) who do not comply with regular school rules will be accompanied by a chaperone for the rest of the day and reported to the principal upon returning to school. Students will be responsible for checking in on a timely manner at our 2:00 p.m. check-in and at the final check-in of 7:00 p.m. If students do not show up in time for the bus, the parents will be called to pick up their child at the Cedar Point Office. Students will be responsible for any other purchases they may wish to make. They may also bring snacks that can be left at the picnic area that will be continually manned by chaperones throughout the day. Only unopened bottles of pop or juice may be brought.

The total cost of \$75.00 CASH includes:

- Admission to Cedar Point.
- Bus Transportation to and from the park.
- Shirt (provided by the school) that MUST be worn that day.

It will be required for safety purposes that the students stay with other Bryant 8th graders during the entire trip. The students **will not** be accompanied by chaperones during their hours in the park.

PAYMENT AND PERMISSION SLIP TURN IN \$75 CASH ONLY. Since we will be collecting cash only, receipts will be issued at the time of payment. Signed Permission slip and fees MUST be turned in together.
