Dearborn Schools Offering Free Lunch, Breakfast to All Students

Dearborn Public Schools is now expanding its free lunch program to all students, regardless of family income. The District was recently informed by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) that it was eligible to offer free meals across the district based on criteria in the Community Eligibility Program (CEP) under the U.S. Department of Agriculture's school meals program. Free meals went into effect as of September 10, 2018.

This is a very exciting time for our district to have the opportunity to serve all students free breakfast and lunch in our schools. Just a reminder that there are still guidelines we have to follow with this program. Please remember that the first meal is free which at breakfast consists of milk, grain, fruit &/or vegetable. Lunch is milk, grain, protein, fruit, vegetable. If a student wants a second meal, it is not free. It would be charged as a breakfast or lunch. If a student only wants a milk, it is not free. It is part of a meal.

At Lunch:

A student must take at least three components in the required serving sizes. One selection must be at least ½ cup from either the fruit or vegetable component.

At Breakfast:

A student must select at least three food items, one of which must be ½ cup of fruit.

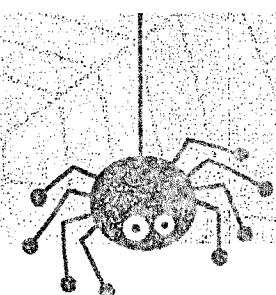

School Zone Safety

The Dearborn Police Department takes your children's safety seriously and so must you. With the beginning of the new school year I would like to remind parents that we understand how congested and frustrating school zones can become in the morning and afternoon when dropping off or picking up children. However, poor driving habits, parking violations, and aggressive driving near schools, all create an unsafe environment for our children. We are asking all parents to do their part in promoting "safe and orderly- school zones" to ensure child safety.

To help reduce congestion and provide a safer environment keep these points in mind when dropping off or picking up your children:

- The bus stop is for buses only.
- Walk children to school when possible.
- Drop off/pick up children a short distance away from school, when/if possible. This alleviates traffic congestion around our schools.
- Once your child is out of the car and safely on the sidewalk vacate the area to make room for other parents to drop off their children. (Do Not - Double Park)
- Be mindful of school staff and crossing guards. They are there for your child's safety.
- Be a 'Good Neighbor', by being mindful of residents who live near school zones.


As part of our commitment to ensuring our children's safety, The Dearborn Police Department will be actively enforcing traffic laws around all school zones:

- Blocking driveways: \$80 fine
- Double parking: \$80 fine
- Stop sign violation: 3 points \$150 fine
- Fail to yield to pedestrian: 2 points \$150 fine
- Fail to yield to School Bus: 3 points \$240 fine
- Disobey a school crossing guard: Misdemeanor

When to Keep Your Child Home from School

Illness	What to do?
Chickenpox	Keep child home until they have no new sores for 24 hours AND all sores are dried and crusted. **During an outbreak of chickenpox, children who are <u>NOT</u> vaccinated for chickenpox (Varicella) and have been in close contact with someone sick with the infection will not be allowed at school for 21 days after they were last exposed to chickenpox, even if they are not sick.
Diarrhea that cannot be controlled and/or with a fever.	Keep child at home.
Fever with temperature 100° or higher and not feeling well enough to participate in class.	Keep child home until fever-free for 24 hours <u>without</u> using fever-reducing medicine such as Motrin or Tylenol.
Flu-like symptoms with fever, chills, sore throat, runny nose, muscle aches, tiredness; may also have vomiting and diarrhea.	Keep child home until symptoms are gone.
Head lice	If lice are first found at school, child may stay until end of the day but may not return until treated and all live lice are gone.
Impetigo	Keep child home until 24 hours after antibiotics have been started.
MRSA	Keep child home if sore is draining and cannot be covered with a clean, dry bandage. Keep child home if they cannot keep from picking at sore.
Rash	Keep child home until seen by a doctor and treated if needed. The school may request a doctor's note to return to school.
Strep throat	Keep child home until 24 hours after antibiotics have been started.
Pink eye with discharge	Keep child home until seen by a doctor and 24 hours after first dose of medicine, if prescribed.
Ringworm	If ringworm is first found at school, child may stay until end of the day if it can be covered. Child may not return until treatment has been started. Area must remain covered until completely healed.
Scabies	Child must stay home until after treatment is started.
Vomiting 2 or more times within 24 hours	Keep child home until able to tolerate regular diet.
