

With existing bonds expiring, the District can generate approximately \$240 million from the sale of new bonds without increasing the current millage rate. This bond would not increase tax rates for residents.

The District is calling the proposal BRICS because the funded projects focus on Buildings, Renovations, Infrastructure, Capacity and Safety. Dearborn Public Schools is asking voter approval on a bond in November 2019.

A bond committee has been working to winnow a list of \$500 million in needed capital improvements, plus additional possible expenses for items like security, capacity, technology and educational upgrades.

- All meals district-wide will continue to be free.
- We pledge a focus on fresh-from-scratch cooking and menu variety.
- Fresh fruit and vegetable salad bars will be available daily at lunch. While this will be free for students who
  purchase a meal, salad bar access also will be available as an a la carte option.
- Full nutritional information is posted for all menu items on the Dearborn Schools website
- The Roving Chef program is available. This fun and interactive culinary program will provide principal-selected students with special instruction in nutrition, proper food safety/cooking techniques and healthy meal preparation—all while working alongside a real chef.
- A variety of entrées will be offered daily to appeal to student tastes and preferences, with on-trend culinary
  concepts that including recipes from a variety of cuisines.
- A selection of 3 entrée choices will be offered daily for Elementary students, consisting of the menu items listed above. Middle Schools will have 4-6 options and High School students will be offered 6-8 options daily.
- A dedicated team of professionals including chefs and nutrition coordinators will be in Dearborn daily working with staff and students.

Along the way, we plan to request frequent feedback from our students through regular taste tests and panels. That's because we are dedicated to creating custom menus and programs that get every student excited to eat at school, knowing they will find nutritious foods that they love. #### Bryant Middle School Traffic Issues

To those who do not know me, I am Corperal Chai Henson and I am a School Researce Officer with the Dearborn Police Department, assigned to Bryant Middle School. I receive many complaints each year about the traffic congestion during the morning arrival and afternoon dismissal periods. I would like to make the following suggestions that I believe will help alleviate many of the reported issues:

- Remain off your cell phone while dropping off/pick-up your child
- Do not text and drive
- Do not park in the vicinity of the Coburn & Vernon intersection or in the bus drop off area
- Do not block any crosswalks/driveways
- Do not pack in any private, residential driveway.
- Do not park more than 12" from the each
- Do not park within 15' of an intersection/fire hydrant
- Do not park within 30° of a stop sign.
- Do not take more than 30 seconds to drop-off, your child
- Do not stop in the roadway and your child to exit your vehicle into oncoming traffic
- Be concleous to all drivers
- Do not drop off your student, facing oncoming traffic (driver side wheels to curb).
- Do not do U-Yums (including pulling into residential driveways) during peak drop-off/pick-up times

If everyone does these things, I believe we will be on our way to creating a safe and efficient pick-up and drop-off environment, free of complaints. It will take the participation and effort of everyone to accomplish this goal.

I have attached a traffic flow pattern that will also assist in increasing safety, reduce congestion and allow for bottor traffic flow during drop-off and pick-up times. Please take a moment and review the etholied traffic flow map and notice the preferred route, which is highlighted in yellow.

I appreciate your continued support and cooperation in this matter and hope we can work together to continuelly improve the safety of everyone in the Hryant Schoel Community,
