

Bryant Middle School Traffic Issues

To those who do not know me, I am Corporal Chad Hensun and I am a School Researce Officer with the Dearborn Police Department, assigned to Bryant Middle School. I receive many complaints each year about the traffic congestion during the morning arrival and afternoon dismissal periods. I would like to make the following suggestions that I believe will help alleviate many of the reported issues:

- Remain off your cell phone while dropping off/pick-up your child
- Do not text and drive.
- Do not pack in the vicinity of the Coburn & Vernon intersection or in the bus drop off area
- · Do not block any crosswalks/dsiveways
- · Do not pack in any private, residential driveway
- . Do not park more than 12" from the early
- Do not park within 15' of an intersection/fire hydrant
- Do not park within 30° of a stop sign
- Do not take more than 30 seconds to drop-off, your child
- Do not stop in the roadway and your child to exit your vehicle into oncoming traffic
- Be courteous to all drivers
- Do not drop off your student, facing oncoming traffic (driver side wheels to carb).
- Do not do U-Turns (including pulling into residential driveways) during peak drop-off/pick-up times

If everyone does these things, I believe we will be on our way to creating a safe and efficient pick-up and drop-off environment, free of complaints. It will take the participation and effort of everyone to accomplish this goal.

I have attached a traffic flow pattern that will also assist in increasing safety, reduce congestion and allow for botter traffic flow during drop-off and pick-up times. Please take a moment and review the ettached traffic flow map and notice the preferred roots, which is highlighted in yellow.

I appreciate your continued support and cooperation; in this matter and hope we can work together to continually improve the safety of everyone in the Hryant School Community,
