## 2020-21 Hybrid Program & Virtual Program

By now many of you have heard that our community has met the health criteria set by the Dearborn Board of Education and we can start our plan to bring students back to in-person learning through a phased in approach. We have worked very hard to develop two plans for students: the Hybrid Learning program or the Virtual Learning program. Each program has been tailored to best meet the needs of our families. Below you will find specific information about the two programs as well as other important information.

Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learn at school through Schoology and Zoom. Students will be supported by a Bryant Middle School classroom teacher</li> <li>• Students have been split into two groups to reduce the number of students in each classroom. The goal is to have classes with 15 students or less</li> <li>• Students with an even address (Blue Group) will attend school on Monday/Thursday of each week for face-to-face instruction. On Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday of each week, students will 'Remote-In' to their classes</li> <li>• Students with an odd address (Gray Group) will attend school on Tuesday/Friday of each week for face-to-face instruction. On Monday, Wednesday and Thursday of each week, students will 'Remote-In' to their classes</li> <li>• Teachers will take attendance each day</li> <li>• Students attending school will follow the safety protocols established by the district</li> <li>• Bryant Middle School teachers will monitor student academic progress and provide feedback to students. Parents will be given progress reports and report cards that communicate student academic progress</li> <li>• Students in the Hybrid program will be asked to remain in this option for the remainder of the school year</li> <li>• Students are able to attend in-person learning labs</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will learn and complete work virtually from home through Schoology and Zoom</li> <li>• Students will be given the option to use a district chromebook and be taught by a Bryant Middle School teacher</li> <li>• Students will be required to attend classes each day and attendance will be taken</li> <li>• Bryant Middle School teachers will monitor student academic progress and provide feedback to students. Parents will be given progress reports and report cards that communicate student academic progress</li> <li>• Students who are placed in the Virtual Learning program will be asked to remain in this program for the duration of the 2020-21 school year</li> <li>• Students will be able to attend and participate in all Bryant Middle School extra curricular functions</li> <li>• Students may not attend in-person learning labs if they are a member of the Virtual Learning program</li> </ul>

Schedule	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 6th Grade Hybrid/VLP Schedule &amp; 7th/8th Grade Hybrid/VLP Schedule</li> <li>● All students will be attending school for live teaching from 8:50 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. From 1:30 - 3:15 p.m. students will be completing assigned work or be invited to a learning lab</li> <li>● Wednesday will be a remote learning day for all students</li> <li>● In-person Learning Labs will restart during the week of February 15th and will continue through, Friday, February 26th. Teachers will schedule time for students to come to the building for support. Learning labs start at 2:00 p.m. and end at 3:15 p.m.</li> <li>● Virtual Learning Labs (2:05 - 3:15 p.m.) for all students will start on Monday, March 1st</li> <li>● The first day of the Hybrid schedule will take place on Monday, March 1st. If a student is not in the building, they should be connecting remotely with their teachers. There will be a gradual transition of students into the building: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 6th grade will transition to face to face learning beginning Monday, March 1st</li> <li>○ 7th grade will transition to face to face learning beginning Monday, March 8th</li> <li>○ 8th grade will transition to face to face learning beginning Monday, March 15th</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Students will learn and complete work through the Schoology platform and be supported by Bryant Middle School teachers</li> </ul>
Hybrid/VLP Schedules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <a href="#">6th Grade Hybrid/Virtual Learning Schedule</a></li> <li>● <a href="#">7th &amp; 8th Grade Hybrid/Virtual Learning Schedules</a></li> </ul> <p>(*All schedules begin on Monday, March 1, 2021)</p>
Student Screening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All students who choose the Hybrid program will need to complete the <a href="#">Bryant Middle School COVID -19 Commitment Form</a></li> <li>● <a href="#">COVID-19 Screening Tool - English &amp; دليل اختبار كوفيد-19 لأولياء الأمور والأهالي</a></li> </ul>
Technology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All students will be entitled to use a district chromebook for remote learning. Personal devices may be used by students for remote learning</li> <li>● Students should request a chromebook by contacting the Bryant Middle School main office</li> <li>● All on-line learning will take place on the Schoology learning management system using Zoom video conferencing</li> <li>● Technology questions can be answered by contacting the Dearborn Schools Help Desk @ (313) 827-3003</li> <li>● Students participating in the Hybrid Learning program should bring the school issued chromebook to school each day. Students will continue to use Schoology and Zoom during in-person instruction</li> <li>● Chromebooks should be charged completely the night before so it is fully charged for the school day. Students may bring their own computer to school, but the school will not be held responsible for lost or damaged devices. Headphones or earbuds will be highly recommended for each student</li> </ul>
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students are allowed to carry a backpack or drawstring bag during the school day</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be given planners and should carry these planners during the school day</li> <li>• Students should bring the following items to school daily: math workbooks, pencils, pens, paper, an independent reading book, folders, etc.</li> <li>• The school will continue to provide school supplies to students.</li> </ul>
Masks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Masks will be required for all staff members and students. This is a district policy and will be enforced consistently and appropriately.</li> <li>• Each student will be receiving 2 masks provided by Dearborn Public Schools. These masks will be distributed to students during Advisory classes upon their return to school. Disposable masks will be available for students upon request</li> <li>• Students not willing to wear a mask within the building will be sent home following parent contact and be enrolled in the Virtual Learning program</li> <li>• Masks must be worn properly (over nose and around chin)</li> </ul>
Arrival/ Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be permitted in the building at 8:40 a.m.</li> <li>• Students should enter the building through the following doors: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 6th grade = Door #6 &amp; Door #1</li> <li>○ 7th grade = Door #7 &amp; Door #1</li> <li>○ 8th grade = Door #1 &amp; Door #7</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Students will be dismissed from school at 1:30 p.m. and exit out the same door that they entered in at the beginning of the day</li> <li>• Students will be monitored by staff during arrival and/or dismissal times</li> <li>• Students should wear a mask and practice 6 ft. social distancing when reporting to/leaving from the building</li> </ul>
Classroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes and disinfectant spray will be available in every classroom</li> <li>• If weather permits, teachers may schedule classes outdoors</li> <li>• No shared materials between students</li> <li>• Students' desks will be socially distanced to the best of our ability (3 - 6 ft.)</li> <li>• All students' desks will be facing the same direction</li> <li>• Assigned seating per class period (for contact tracing purposes)</li> <li>• Limited eating or drinking in the classrooms</li> <li>• Students can bring water bottles and use them during the day</li> <li>• Staff will wipe down high-contact common surfaces throughout the school day</li> </ul>
Student Meals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be given breakfast upon entry to the building and will eat during their 1st hour class</li> <li>• Students will be required to stay in their assigned area while eating and after eating. Movement will be discouraged when students are eating in the classroom</li> <li>• Students will be asked to clean their area once breakfast has ended</li> <li>• The family meal distribution will continue during this stage of learning. Meals will be available on Wednesdays from 10:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. starting Wednesday, March 3rd</li> </ul>
Hallway	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Signage on the floors encouraging proper social distancing and one way direction (students stay to the right when one way traffic isn't possible)</li> <li>• Staggered passing time for 6th graders &amp; 7th/8th graders</li> <li>• The 'horseshoe' area of the school will be one way only</li> <li>• Drinking fountains have been disabled; water filling stations are available for students</li> </ul>

Restrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students will be permitted to use restrooms that are accessible in the classroom or will be able to use the large restrooms located by the main office.</li> <li>● Students will be allowed to use the restroom during class with a pass from the teacher. To minimize large group gatherings, restrooms will be closed during passing time</li> </ul>
Lockers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students will NOT be permitted to use a locker when attending Bryant Middle School for face to face instruction</li> <li>● Students will be carrying all of their belongings to each class</li> </ul>
Cell Phones	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students will be allowed to carry a cell phone during the school day. Cell phones should be turned off and stored in student backpacks during the school day</li> <li>● Cell phones are not to be used during student entry to the building, during passing times or during student dismissal</li> <li>● The school will not be held responsible for a student's lost or stolen cell phone</li> </ul>
Outside Visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Visitors will have very limited access to Bryant Middle School. Visitors should schedule an appointment with the school prior to coming to school in order to provide a safe environment for visitors and staff members.</li> <li>● All visitors must sign-in and complete the safety guideline questions prior to entering the office</li> <li>● All visitors are required to wear a mask and 6ft social distancing</li> <li>● A majority of appointments will continue to take place using the Zoom video conference tool</li> </ul>
Code of Conduct	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All students are expected to follow the Dearborn Schools Code of Conduct. We expect students to follow the PBIS guidelines: Be Safe, Be Responsible and Be Respectful.</li> <li>● The Dearborn Schools Code of Conduct still applies to those attending classes for face to face instruction or using any of the on-line platforms. If a student's conduct disrupts the educational process for themselves and/or others there will be alternate learning options recommended. Students who cannot adhere to the District Technology Acceptable Use Policy could have their technology privileges disabled and be forced to learn by completing hard copies of their assignments.</li> </ul>
