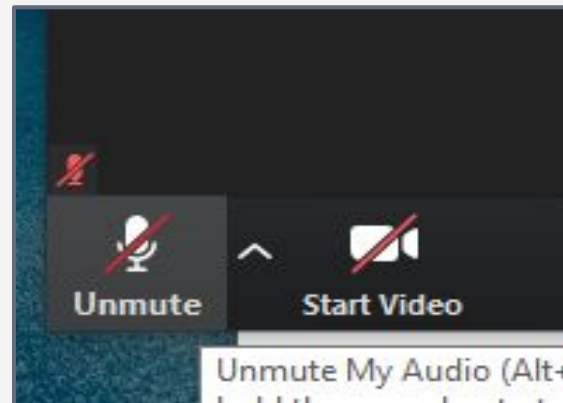

Hybrid Learning Plan

- Students split into 2 groups to reduce the number of students in each classroom
 - ◆ Even Address: In-person on M/Th & Remote on T, W and F
 - ◆ Odd Address: In-person on T/F & Remote on M, W and Th
- In-person learning component
- Continue to use Schoology & Zoom platforms
- Student attendance is taken daily
- Students are asked to remain in this program for the rest of the 2020-21 school year

Virtual Learning Plan

- 100% remote
- Students use Schoology & Zoom platforms
- Student attendance is taken daily
- Students in the VLP will remain virtual for the entire 2020-21 school year
- Students attend remotely with Hybrid students

Hybrid Phase-In Timeline

Week of March 1st: 6th graders in the building following the middle school Hybrid/VLP schedule (Even/Odd). 7th + 8th graders at remote learning at home following Hybrid/VLP schedule

Week of March 8th: 6th + 7th graders in the building following the middle school Hybrid/VLP schedule (Even/Odd). 8th graders at remote learning at home following Hybrid/VLP schedule

Week of March 15th: 6th - 8th graders in the building following the middle school Hybrid/VLP schedule (Even/Odd)

Remote Learning Wednesdays: All students (Hybrid or VLP) will attend remotely from home with Zoom

*Please note that all students will be learning remotely on March 4, 5, 11 and 12 (Staff vaccinations - Shot #2)

Student Health Screening

- Parents complete the Bryant Middle School Covid-19 Commitment Form
- Covid-19 Health Screening Tool - All families should screen students at home before the start of the school day
- Wayne County Covid-19 Screening Tool

Student Safety Protocols

- Students must wear a mask while at school. The mask must fit properly (over nose and around chin)
- Students should practice safe social distancing
 - ◆ 3 - 6 ft. in classrooms (6ft. preferred)
 - ◆ 6 ft. in hallways
- Students should wash hands frequently (soap and water in classrooms + restroom)
- Hand sanitizer will be available for students in each classroom
- Disinfectant spray and disinfectant wipes are available in each classroom
- Students will have an assigned seat in each classroom
- If students are ill they must stay home from school

Building Cleaning Protocols

- ❖ Hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes and disinfectant spray is available in every classroom
- ❖ Staff will wipe down high-contact areas throughout the school day
- ❖ Students may wipe down their desk area and shared computer keyboards
- ❖ Electrostatic sprayer w/ hypochlorous solution and/or disinfectant (75% alcohol) will be used to disinfect classrooms and hallways each day
- ❖ Staff will keep soap dispensers filled
- ❖ Provide hand sanitizer and PPE for students and staff

Use of Restrooms

- Lock restrooms prior to the start of school day and during passing times
- Allow for limited use during the class period
- Monitored by staff members
- Students sign-in/sign-out so students can be monitored

Quarantine Protocol at Bryant

- If a student is displaying symptoms of an illness, the classroom teacher will send the student to the office.
- Student will be evaluated using COVID 19 Screening Tool.
- A symptomatic student will remain in a supervised quarantine room and parents will be contacted by office staff.
- Upon arrival, parents will receive a copy of the screening tool and a letter from the office.
- School nurse will follow up with both parents and administration.
- Your child requires a letter from his/her health care provider stating that the student is not contagious with an infectious disease and may return to school.

Classrooms

- ★ Students will adhere to a seating chart created by each teacher.
- ★ Students will sit at separate seats with 3-6ft spacing between tables.
- ★ Teachers will continue to use Schoology and Zoom.
- ★ In person instruction will take place simultaneously with students remoting in to access instruction.



Hallways & Transitions



- Students will have 5 minutes to transition from class to class.
- Sixth grade will have a staggered schedule to reduce hallway flow.
- Decals are placed in hallways to identify directions and support social distancing.

Student Lockers

- Due to the current circumstances, student lockers will not be available for storing belongings.
- We are encouraging students to use a backpack or drawstring bag to place all their belongings; including their electronics.
- Students will be allowed to carry a backpack during the school day during this year.

Technology & Learning Materials

- Students should bring chromebook to school each day; charged and ready to use
- Students will carry materials from class to class. A backpack or drawstring bag may be used by students.
- Students should bring math workbook, folders, pens, pencils, etc. to school for in-person learning
- Students will be assigned a planner and should be used by students to help with organization

Bryant Notification Center

Bryant Middle School has two communication boards located in the hallway between the main doors and the front doors. The purpose of these boards is to communicate with students that an item has been dropped off. A large note with the student name will be posted on the communication board. Students should remove the note and bring it to the office to retrieve the item.

In order to minimize exposures and contact, we will place a **drop off box** outside of the main door. If your child requires an item during the school day, please contact the office to the notify them an item has been left in the drop off box upon arrival to the building.



Arrival & Dismissal

- Students may enter the building at 8:40 a.m. Students arriving to school prior to this time will remain outside until the appropriate time.
- Students are expected to leave the school property by 1:30 p.m. unless involved in an after-school activity or scheduled to attend a face to face Learning Lab.
- Any student leaving early will be released only from the office. No student will be released until an authorized adult comes into the office to sign the child out and the adult has been identified. An adult may be required to show identification to office personnel to ensure the safety of our students.



Entry/Dismissal Doors

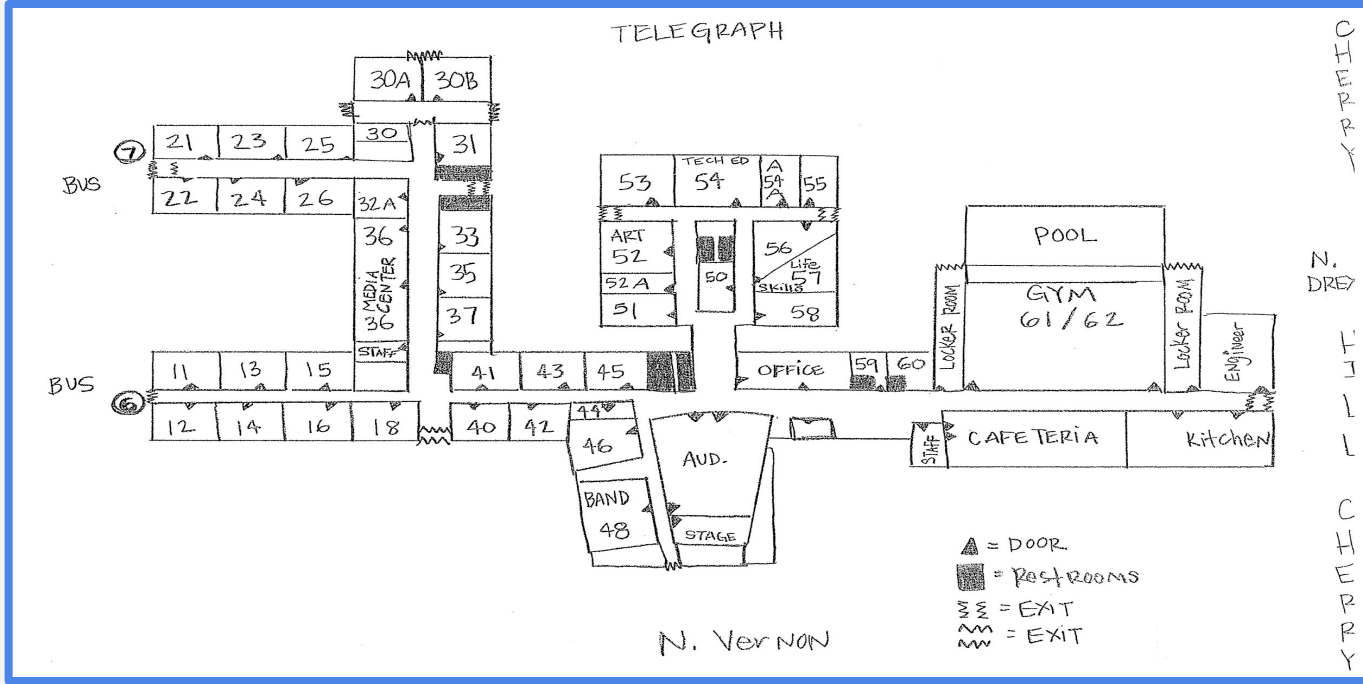
→ 6th Grade = Door #1 or Door #6

Bus Transportation

- ❑ Students will still be able to ride a bus to school; Transportation mailed information to eligible students
- ❑ Students must wear a mask while riding a bus
- ❑ Hand sanitizer will be on each bus
- ❑ Students should space themselves away from each other on the bus
- ❑ Transportation personnel will sanitize bus in between routes

Student Meals

- Students will be offered a breakfast upon entry to the building (dry snacks, juice, apple slices, milk, etc.). Students will eat this during Advisory
- Family meals will continue. Distribution of these meals will take place on Wednesdays (starting March 3rd) from 10:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. outside door #18 by Dearborn Schools Food Service

Attendance

- The Bryant administration and staff believe in the value of regular attendance in order for students to receive the full benefit from their educational experience and the essential components of learning. School attendance is the joint responsibility of the students, parents and the school (Hybrid and Virtual Learning Programs)
- Students are expected to arrive on time and attend all all classes. If a student is absent, they must connect with all teachers to obtain work they missed

Cell Phones & Electronic

- Students can carry cell phones during the day.
- Cell phones and other electronics are not to be seen or heard at any time during the school day.
- Staff members will confiscate all cell phones/electronic devices.
- Bryant Middle School is NOT responsible for lost or stolen cell phones or electronic devices.
 - ◆ 1st offense - Device is returned to parent the following day
 - ◆ 2nd offense - Device is returned to parent the following Monday
 - ◆ 3rd offense - Parent meeting required
- Cell phones should be turned off and put away prior to entering the building and turned on when the student leaves the building



Parental Involvement

- The school would like to continue to develop a positive rapport with parents and other stakeholders
- During the Hybrid/VLP programs, the majority of meetings will need to be scheduled in advance and held virtually (Zoom)
- Check your child's planner daily and use Parent Connect regularly to view and discuss your child's attendance, assignments, grades and test scores.
- When visiting the school all visitors are required to wear masks and socially distance from one another.
- Continue to communicate with teachers using email, phone calls, Schoology, Google apps, etc.

First Day Back to School

- ★ Monday, March 1st = 6th graders w/ an Even Address & Tuesday, March 2nd = 6th graders w/ an Odd Address
- ★ Bryant staff & administration will be greet students and be visible (Outside & Inside the building)
- ★ 6th graders can enter the building through Door #1 or Door #6
- ★ Students report to Advisory Class and will be given a hard copy of their schedule (w/ teacher & room assignments)
- ★ Virtual Orientation during 1st hour for all students (Monday, March 1st)
