**FOOD SERVICE FOR BRYANT SCHOOL**

## BRYANT MEDIA CENTER



Window-side Library Checkout is now available to Bryant students on Tuesdays for the next several weeks from 1:00 -2:30 pm at the outdoor library window. Students can place holds for books by logging into the library catalog (see video How-To below). Once a student places the hold, we will get the book then email the student to let him/her know the book is ready to pick up.

\*Students need to hear from us before coming to get books.

\*Any student with overdue books can turn these in at this time as well.

\*Hold placed on pickup day by 10:00 am can usually be picked up the same day.

\*2 book limit per student

\*FYI...the library has a driveway behind it and a very colorful mural along the driveway wall-the library windows are visible from there.

\*There are signs on the windows to show students where to go.

\*Students would need to have not overdue items or fines currently to check out books.
