Students Receive 2 Degrees

- Typical High SchoolDiploma
- You remain part of your home school
- You can participate in all school activities including Prom, sports, graduation ceremony, etc.
- Earn 60+ transferable credits.

- Spend the first two years at your home school and then begin taking classes at HFC at the beginning of your junior year.
- No classes in your high school after your senior year.

Typical Course Sequence

11th grade

Semester 1: College 101

Semester 2: Intro to Political Science, Humanities

12th grade

One class each semester at the high school, rest at HFC

13th grade

All classes at the college

Now Mhat Do I Dos

- Eligibility based on:
- Student has to be on target to graduate
- Student has to achieve College Ready PSAT test scores: This test is given in April of the sophomore year.
- EBRW: 460 Math: 510
- Grades are not a factor for admission

To Review: No cost to students or parents

- All tuition, fees and books are covered
- Students may continue to participate in all high school sports and activities through 12th grade
- Dearborn School Counselor and HFC advisors provide support at the college and assists with planning for transfer to a 4-year degree program at graduation
- Support in your college classes with tutoring and mentoring when needed.
- You choose what you want to major in.

More Highlights

- Complete the program in 5 years
- Students always a part of their home school
- Walk in commencement ceremony, then all the rest of your classes are at HFC.
- 4 year colleges see the students as incoming freshman so can receive all freshman scholarships they qualify for
- Credits transfer

A few more key points:

- Transportation is not provided
- Grades are not part of the eligibility for this program
- No cap for the number of students invited.
- Students free to change their mind and leave the program after their junior year. Student will then graduate with his/her class.
