The Michigan Interim Teaching Certificate, enables candidates who have successfully completed the pre-certification courses, to become certified classroom teachers. Currently certified teachers can also add subject and grade level endorsements to their certificate. The teachers will work with peer mentors, attend workshops and professional development conferences, and complete prescribed coursework during the initial three years of teaching.

Program completers can be recommended by Schoolcraft College for the Michigan Provisional Teaching Certificate. Schoolcraft College will work with local school districts to help identify teaching positions and also recommend qualified program completers for appropriate placements. Candidates will be responsible for arranging for their initial teaching position.

The State of Michigan's admission requirements for the program are:

- ✓ Minimum of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- ✓ Minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 point scale. Individuals with a GPA lower than 3.0 may contact the Teacher Education office to have their transcripts evaluated.
- ✓ Pass the new (March 2016 or later) SAT Exam. Prior MTTC Professional Readiness Exam (PRE) and MTTC Basic Skills Exam results can also be used*
- ✓ Pass the applicable MTTC Subject Area Exam(s). Note: Candidates seeking an endorsement in a world language or English as a second language must pass both the oral and written proficiency examinations.
- ✓ Documentation of current certification in CPR and First Aid (prior to recommendation for the Interim Certificate)
- ✓ Criminal history check (Fingerprinting will be required by school districts for employment.)
