The Dearborn Board of Education (hereinafter referred to as the Board), and the Dearborn Federation of School Employees (hereinafter referred to as the DFSE agree to the following.

Due to the increasing need for installing and fixing structured cabling projects, including cameras, drops, key card boxes, and other essential devices, the Structured Cabler position is essential to working on these projects during evenings and possibly weekends so that instruction is not interrupted. The Structured Cabler position would be instrumental in assisting the Technology Department and District Operations Department in collaborative projects on infrastructure and security needs and would be under the supervision of the District Operations Department.

A new 6-step salary schedule will be created for this position. This position will be under the Trades Classification and will follow all the trades contractual language.
