LETTER OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN

DEARBORN SCHOOLS OPERATING ENGINEERS ASSOCIATION AND DEARBORN BOARD OF EDUCATION

Update Job Requirements

The Dearborn Board of Education (hereinafter referred to as the Board), and the Dearborn Schools Operating Engineers Association (hereinafter referred to as the DSOEA), whereas the above mentioned parties agree as follows:

Article IX #3 will be updated as follows: (New language is bolded)

- 3. All engineers hired after February 1, 1991 will be required to have the following minimum qualifications:
 - a. City of Dearborn High Pressure Boiler Operators License.
 - b. An Associate's Degree in Management or Building Engineer Certificate Program. A high school diploma or equivalent.

For the Dearborn Schools Operating

As a condition of continued employment, each engineer hired on or after February 1,

- 1991, shall complete a minimum of six semester hours in management and supervision
- courses as approved by the Director of Maintenance & Safety or Director of Facility
- Services or his designee.

For the Board of Education

Any new promotion to any of the following classifications will require, as a primary consideration, the designated license:
