PREMIER CITIZEN DISCOUNT CARD

Each building is supplied with Premier Citizen Discount Cards (formerly Golden Ager Cards) and a sign-up sheet. Senior citizens may pick up their cards from a school in their neighborhood, as well as from the Communications Office.

When assigning a PREMIER CITIZEN DISCOUNT CARD, the person:

- must show identification (driver's license or I.D. Card)
- must be at least 60 years of age
- must be a resident of the Dearborn Public School District
- must sign and fill in the information on the Senior Citizen Sign-up Sheet

Cards will expire on September 30, 2021. Send the Senior Citizen Sign-up Sheet to the Communications Office at the end of the school year.

Cards may be used for:

- Free admission to all school-sponsored activities including concerts and athletic events. Please be sure those who collect at gates and ticket offices are aware that they must honor this card. (Due to fees charged to schools for licensing of performance rights, plays are not included.)
- Discounts on select Community Education classes.
- 10% discount on merchandise sold at school stores. (limit 4 items per year)
- Participation in school lunch programs at reduced prices. Reduced price is 10% discount on the total purchase.

NOTE: The card says that advance notice to the school is required for participation in the lunch program. You will want to stress this notice requirement with senior citizens in your neighborhood, particularly if you are not a base kitchen.

This is an opportunity to have senior citizens come into our school buildings to see our programs in action. When senior citizens come in for their cards, invite them to your activities. Open houses, musical events, sporting events, etc., give us a chance to show the community how well our students are performing.
