Dear Dearborn families of 3rd-5th grade students,

State testing will begin next week. The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) submitted a request to waive testing administration and accountability this year due to COVID-19. MDE has been notified that the request was denied and schools are required to take the M-Step test this spring.

Although State standardized assessments do not measure everything important about a student, it is one data indicator, among many others, about how much a student knows in terms of our state's content standards in that grade level. We encourage all families to make sure their children are present for testing.

The M-STEP assessments will be administered within the following testing windows.

More detailed information regarding assessments schedules will be sent to families from their home school principals. All testing will follow Dearborn's safety protocols.
