



Summer Learning: Math and Literacy

The Dearborn Public Schools acknowledge that summer learning improves the success of each and every student. To ensure our students are prepared to enter the 6th, 7th and 8th grade successfully, we require the following summer work:

Math:

- Log in to MobyMax* and spend 60 minutes a week on math.
- Pass the Basic Skills tests listed under the grade **YOU WILL BE ENTERING**, in the fall.
The Basic Skills tests are on iLearn under Middle School Summer Learning for your school.

Literacy:

- Log on to MobyMax* and spend 60 minutes a week on vocabulary and language.
- Reading:
 1. Go to Lexile.com
 2. Enter your lexile number or range
 3. Click on any type of genre and submit
 4. Create a reading list
 5. Fill out reading log for each book read (*see link on iLearn page*)
 6. Keep the [“how-to” guide](#) handy!
- You may also go to the [Dearborn Public Library](#) website to choose a book or participate in the summer reading program. Complete a reading log for each book read.
