Hello Parents,

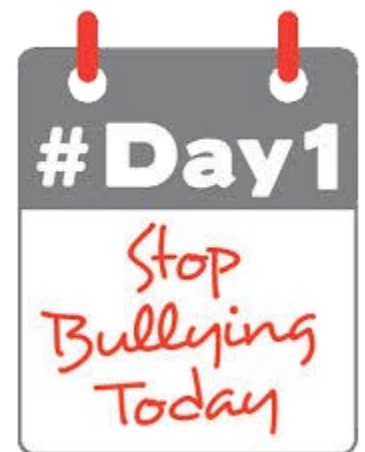
On the first full day of school, all the Salina Intermediate staff and students took the upstander pledge to end bullying.
