The following is a list of activities that may be available for your child:

ACADEMIC GAMES- (6-8th) This is an opportunity for students to use their math skills in competition with other Dearborn middle school students. Lasting ten weeks, practices are held after school. Games are usually played on Wednesdays. Competition is open to all students. Participation in this activity can be very beneficial to increasing math skills.

CHEERLEADING- (6-8th) There are two cheerleading squads. One cheers for football and girls' basketball and the other for boys' basketball. This gives students an opportunity to participate in both athletics and cheerleading.

CHESS TEAM (6-8th) Learning to play one of the most challenging strategy games, Chess Team helps students learn through competition. Twice a week, from November through April, Chess Team members develop mind-developing skills! In-city and state tournaments add to the excitement of chess.
