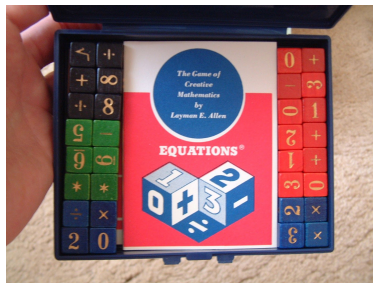




*** STUDENT ACADEMIC GAMES TRAINING ***
