Student Council provides leadership development opportunities to prepare and empower student leaders to serve O.L. Smith and their community.

It offers:

- **Leadership**—Supporting the development of leadership skills and knowledge
- **Service**—Helping build a climate of caring and tolerance through volunteerism and service to others
- **Student Voice**—Promoting student council as the voice of the student body and giving every student an opportunity to be heard
- **Engagement**—Encouraging students to become involved in school and community leadership and decision making

It requires:

- **Commitment**– to attending meetings and events sponsored by the council. Missing 2 or more meetings results in removal even if you are in another school-sponsored club/activity.
 - Meetings are held EVERY 2nd and 4th THURSDAY from 3:15-4:15 while school is virtual (Once school is live, the Student Council will vote to decide the meeting time and day)
- **Exemplary Behavior**– as leaders of the school and the community, your actions serve as a role model. Be respectful, be responsible and be safe.
- **Desire**– to help others, encourage your classmates, **and promote school spirit.**

Participation is limited to 6 students per grade-level and is decided through a majority vote.
