



O.L. Smith Dress Code



Any article deemed distracting to the learning environment is open to administration review

Use the examples below as general guidance.

- Backpacks and swag/sling bags are not allowed in the classrooms. They must remain in the students lockers during the day.
- Only purses the size of your hand.
- No sagging pants - pants must cover undergarments.
- Shorts and skirts must come no higher than bottom of fingers when arms extended down resting at sides.
- Any tight/form-fitting bottoms **cannot be worn** unless a skirt or shorts are covering the area from the bottom of fingers when arms are extended down resting at sides. (A wrapped sweater will not suffice)
 - This applies to tight jeans, leggings, jeggings, spandex and other tight bottoms.
 - When in doubt, consider tight bottoms the same as bare skin.
- Clothing must be free of words/graphics referring to drugs, violence, sexual connotations, or gang references.
- Tank top straps, shirt straps, sleeves must be at least two fingers wide; shirts must cover bras and bra-straps completely.
- Jeans/Pants/Trousers must be free of tears, rips, and holes in the area from the bottom of fingers when arms extended down resting at sides.
 - Holes larger than the diameter of a half-dollar (about 1.25 inches in diameter) are too large in any area of the bottoms and are in violation of dress code.
 - Mutilating/cutting clothing at school will not be permitted.
- Shirts must cover midriff.
- No sleepwear allowed.
- No sunglasses, hats, hoods.
- All shoes and sandals must have back or strap around the heels.
- No Outerwear Coats. Hooded sweatshirts and light track jackets will be permitted.
