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## Junior Forensics Lab Class Descriptions

### Discover Detection

Step into the shoes of a detective and uncover the science involved in evidence gathering and analysis. Students will create, collect and analyze evidence and discover what skills are necessary as a crime scene lab technician. Students use a **Fingerprint Finder** to place and identify UV prints.

### Crime Lab

Analyze clues and get hot on the trail of a culprit with the Crime Lab program. With the **Spynoculars** take home, students safely observe clues from afar. The build-your-own binoculars help students develop observational skills.

### Sleuths on the Scene

Suspects, schematics and sleuths...oh my! Connect the dots using science to help solve a crime in this hands-on investigation in the Sleuths on the Scene Lab. Students continue their sleuthing using their **Scene Solver** take home to reconstruct the scene of a crime with family and friends.
