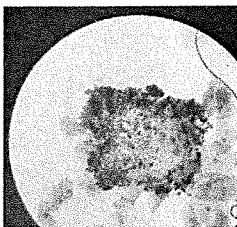
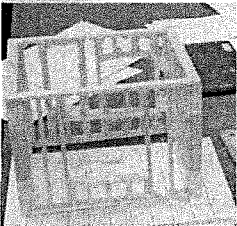

Bosch Scholars Scholarship Application Form
