Session One

Drugs & Your Body: It Isn't Pretty

This 55-min session provides students with scientific facts and engages them in critical thinking. The topics covered in this unit include the following:

- 1. How drugs affect different parts of the body specifically the brain, the skin, the lungs, the heart, and the oral cavity. (pictures and poster will be used for this section).
- 2. How drugs can affect the delicate balance between the brain and body.
- 3. How drugs have nonphysical effects on their lives (e.g., difficult relationships, poor grades, problems with friends).
- 4. How drugs can cause lasting physical or mental problems.
- 5. It will help students understand the concept of addiction.
- 6. How an individual's drug abuse can affect friends and family and become a public health problem for society at large.
