You Have the Right:

- 1. To receive benefits, services and instructional materials in a manner that may be easily understood.
- 2. To receive information that describes the availability of supports and services and how to access them.
- 3. To receive information in non-English languages
- 4. To receive interpreter services free-of-charge for non-English languages.
- 5. To be provided with written materials in alternative formats and how to obtain them for those who are visually and or are hearing impaired or have limited reading proficiency.
- 6. To receive information within a reasonable time after enrollment.
- 7. To be provided freedom of choice among network Providers.
- 8. To receive information on the grievance, appeal and fair hearing processes.
- To receive information that provides information on how to obtain benefits from out-ofnetwork Providers.
- 10. To provide information on how to access 911, emergency, and post-stabilization services.
- 11. To receive information on how to obtain referrals for specialty care and other benefits that is not provided by the primary care Provider.
- 12. To be made aware of those services that is not covered and may involve cost sharing if any.
- 13. To receive information on advance directives.
- 14. To be provided with information on the structure and operation of the Authority.
- 15. To be provided with timely written notice of any significant State and Provider network related changes.
- 16. To be provided with information annually about enrollee rights and protections.
- 17. To be treated with dignity and respect.
- 18. To receive information on available treatment options.
- 19. To participate in decisions regarding health care, the refusal of treatment and preferences for future treatment decisions.
- 20. To be provided with information on services that is not covered on moral /religious basis.

Children's Waiver Programs (CWP)

- The Children's Home and Community Based Services Waiver Program (CWP) provides services that are enhancements or additions to regular Medicaid coverage to children up to age 18 who are enrolled in the CWP. The Children's Waiver is a fee-for-service program administered by the Community Mental Health Service Provider (CMHSP). The CMHSP is responsible for assessment of potential waiver candidates.

Autism Services for Children

Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) is a range of complex neurodevelopment disorders, characterized by social impairments, communication difficulties, and restricted, repetitive, and stereotyped patterns of behavior. Classical autism is the most severe form of ASD, while other conditions along the spectrum include a milder form known as Asperger syndrome, and childhood disintegrative disorder and pervasive developmental disorder not otherwise specified (usually referred to as PDD-NOS). Although ASD varies significantly in character and severity, it occurs in all ethnic and socioeconomic groups and affects every age group.

Once screened, if the ASD is indicated; you want to have a trained professional determine if your child has an Autism Diagnosis through **Assessment** and **Testing**. Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) is an evidence-based treatment based on the science of learning and behavior. ABA is a set of principles that form the basis for many behavioral treatments that encourages positive behaviors and discourages negative behaviors in order to improve a variety of skills. ABA must be provided by provided in trained and skilled professional. ABA therapy can be used to:

- Increase language
- Increase communication skills
- Improve attention
- Improve focus
- Improve social skills
- Improve memory
- Improve academics

The parents or primary caregivers need to know and understand the ABA therapy goals, behavior plans, and strategies so well that in the ABA therapists' absence they could independently teach the skills to their child. ABA just isn't as effective without a team approach. If the behaviors that the ABA therapist teaches to the child are not generalized, reinforced, and maintained by the family, the therapy will not be successful.
