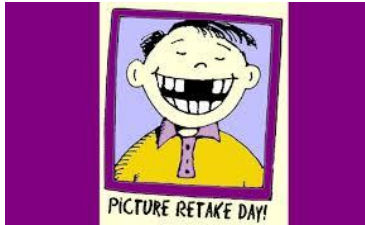

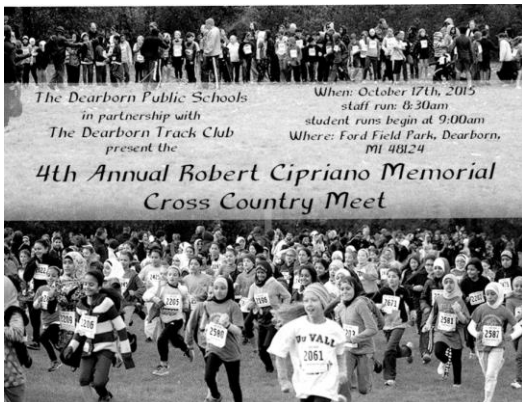
### Study Hall: Tuesdays & Thursdays
