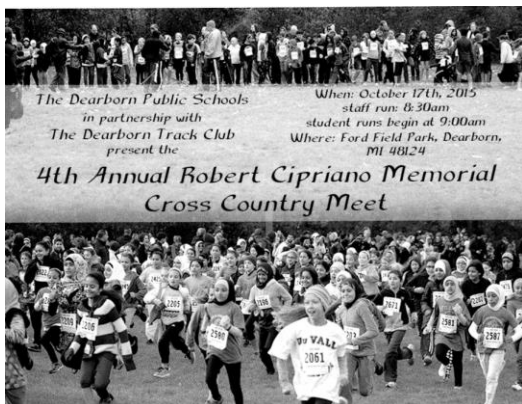
Study Hall: Tuesdays & Thursdays
