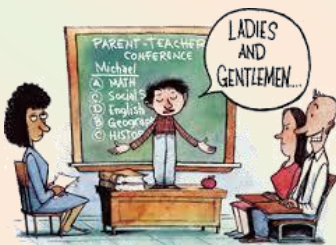
Halloween songs: Wednesday, October 28th
