# National Geography Bee Contest \$50,000 College Scholarship

Stout Middle School will be participating in a National Geography Bee contest.

- *Grades 6, 7, and 8 will be eligible.*
- The top 10 scorers of all grades will have a final round that will reduce the contestants to only 2, who will compete for the School Championship in the last week of January, 2016.
- The champion will receive his medal and will have an online quiz before February 5, 2016 to qualify for the State Bees.
- The State Bees will be held on Friday, April, 2016.
- Transportation and accommodation will be the responsibility of the student and parents.
- The state champion will receive a medal, cash award, and other prizes, while the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners will receive cash awards and prizes.
- The National Bee will take place on Monday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> through Wednesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>.
- The finals will be **televised**.

1<sup>st</sup> Place: a \$50,000 college scholarship, lifetime membership in the National

#### National Geography Bee Contest

Stout Middle School will be participating in a National Geography Bee contest. Grades 6, 7, and 8 will be eligible. The preliminary stage round will include 7 rounds of 35 questions each. The questions will be provided by National Geographic and will be given to the teachers administering the contest on just before the contest starts. The top 10 scorers of all grades will have a final round that will reduce the contestants to only 2. A judge and a moderator will administer the school's championship round. Deadline is the last week of January, 2016. The champion will receive his medal and then will be registered and have an online qualifying quiz before February 5, 2016.

The State Bees will be conducted on Friday, April, 2016. The time and location will be sent to those who qualified. Transportation and accommodation will be the responsibility of the student. The state champion will receive a medal, cash award, and other prizes while the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners will receive cash awards and prizes.

The National Bee will be held on Monday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> through Wednesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>. The finals will be televised. Here are the prizes:
