National Geography Bee Contest: \$85,000 in College Scholarship

Do you know your continents, countries, capitals, rivers, mountains, etc. ...? If you do, then the **National Geography Bee** contest is where you want to be. The contest is open to all grades. It offers Prizes of more than \$85,000 in college scholarships, and \$5,000 in cash.

- The School Championship will be held in the **last week of January, 2016.**
- The champion will have an **online qualifying quiz before February 5, 2016** to represent Stout in the **State Bees** that will be held on **Friday, April, 1st 2016.**
- The **state champion** will receive a **medal, cash award, and other prizes,** and represent the State of Michigan in a televised **National Bee Finals** that will take place on **Monday, May 23rd through Wednesday, May 25th.**
- Here are some of the prizes:
 - 1st Place: a **\$50,000 college scholarship, lifetime membership in the National Geographic Society, \$500 in cash, and a prize trip to a national park.**
 - 2nd Place: a **\$25,000 college scholarship, and \$500 in cash.**
 - 3rd Place: a **\$10,000 college scholarship, and \$500 in cash.**
 - Seven Runners-up: **\$500 in cash for each runner-up.**
