**National Geography Bee Contest: \$85,000 in College Scholarship**

Do you know your continents, countries, capitals, rivers, mountains, etc...? If you do, then the **National Geography Bee** contest is where you want to be. The contest is open to all grades. It offers Prizes of more than **\$85,000** in college scholarships, and **\$5,000** in cash.

- The School Championship will be held in the **last week of January, 2016.**
- The champion will have an **online qualifying quiz** before **February 5, 2016** to represent Stout in the **State Bees** that will be held on **Friday, April, 1<sup>st</sup> 2016.**
- The state champion will receive a **medal, cash award, and other prizes**, and represent the State of Michigan in a televised **National Bee Finals** that will take place on **Monday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> through Wednesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>.**
- Here are some of the prizes:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place: **a \$50,000 college scholarship, lifetime membership in the National Geographic Society, \$500 in cash, and a prize trip to a national park.**
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: **a \$25,000 college scholarship, and \$500 in cash.**
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: **a \$10,000 college scholarship, and \$500 in cash.**
  - Seven Runners-up: **\$500 in cash for each runner-up.**
