It is that time of the year again, and many children are in need of toys that could draw much-needed smiles on their faces.

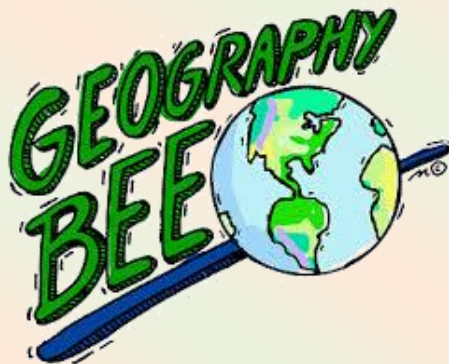
