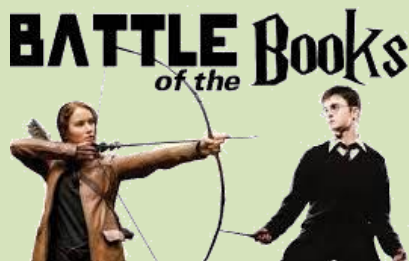
Stout Boys Basketball Team Beat Visiting Lowrey
