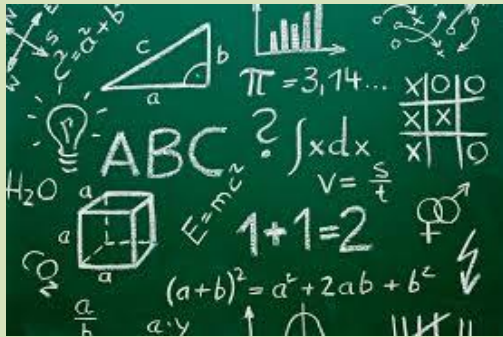




Today is "B" Day
