### Boys Basketball Team Defeats Unis

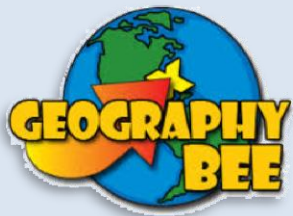

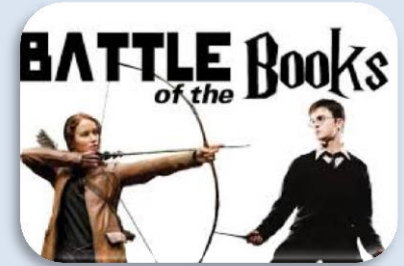


## Be1 Club Meeting Rescheduled: Wednesday, Jan. 13
