GeoBee Preliminary Round: Jan. 21

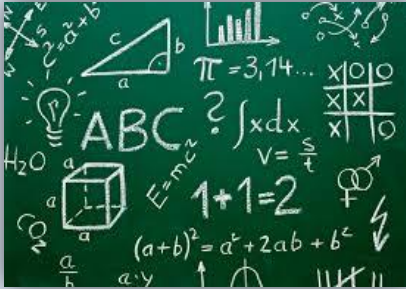
Start practicing for the GeoBee contest. The preliminary round is on Thursday, Jan. 21, 2016. Get yourself a jump-start by preparing earlier.
