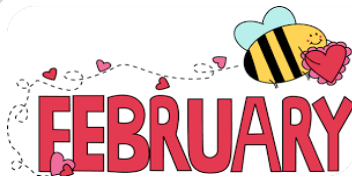

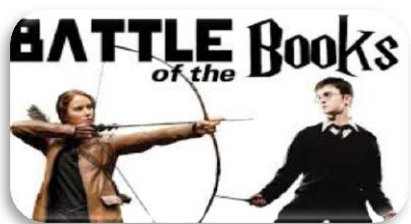


Math League Contest: Feb. 23
