the opportunity to otherwise. So remember your dollars on Wednesday, March 2nd to purchase tasty treats to help kids in need!



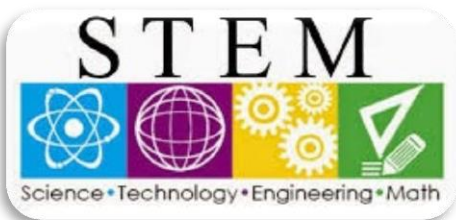
Fun Activity Day: March 3
