Edsel Ford High Cheer Try-outs

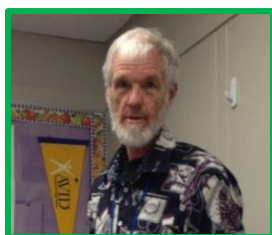
Cheer Try-outs for 8th graders attending Edsel Ford High School next year will be held on:
