Cheerleading Football and Basketball try-outs for 8 graders attending Edsel Ford High School next year will be held on:

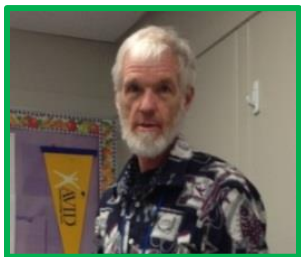
Tuesday, May 17th 3:30– 6:00 pm (middle schoolers be there by 3:30 pm)
