## Last Chance to Edsel Ford Cheerleading Try-outs

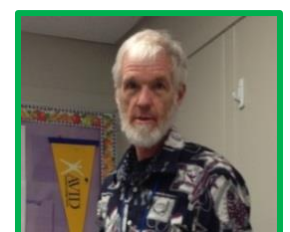
