Ms. Flatt will not be tutoring on Thursday, May 26. Please make sure you take your regular bus ride home.

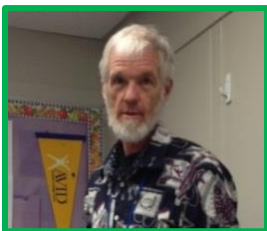
## Last Chance to Edsel Ford Cheerleading Try-outs
