To get full participation points you need to **dress and pay \$1 for each of these days**. Come on Falcons we can do it! Thanks – Ms. Poloni

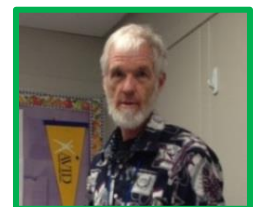


CRSD Annual Summer Slam: June 4 – June 5
