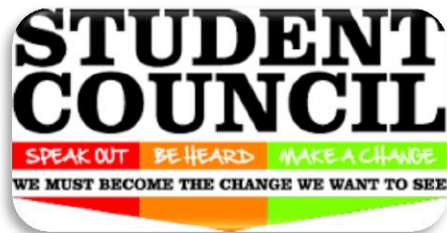


### Need a Parent/Guardian at DHS Home Football Games

Do you like to play board games? Are you a card gamer? Do you think video games are too high tech? Go old school! Come play tabletop games at Games Club with Mr. Melvin.

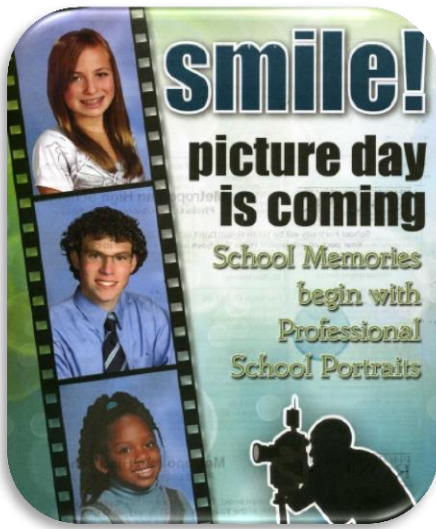
