Do you like to play board games? Are you a card gamer? Do you think video games are too high tech? Go old school! Come play tabletop games at Games Club with Mr. Melvin.




Games Club will begin meeting Friday, October 7th, and meet every Friday after that. We meet from 3:00 until 5:00 after school in room D-4. To participate:
