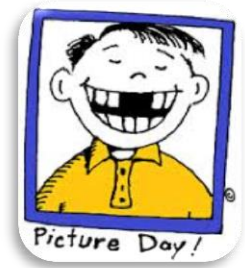


No Halloween Costumes This Year

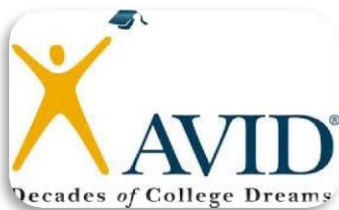


No Games Club This Friday
