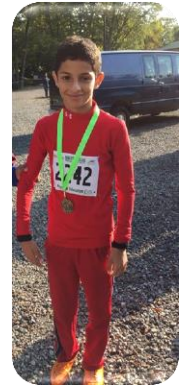


Today is "B" Day

Dodgeball Tournament: Friday, Oct. 21

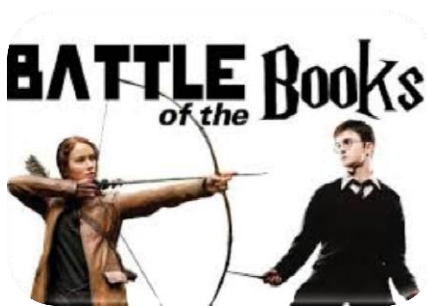
