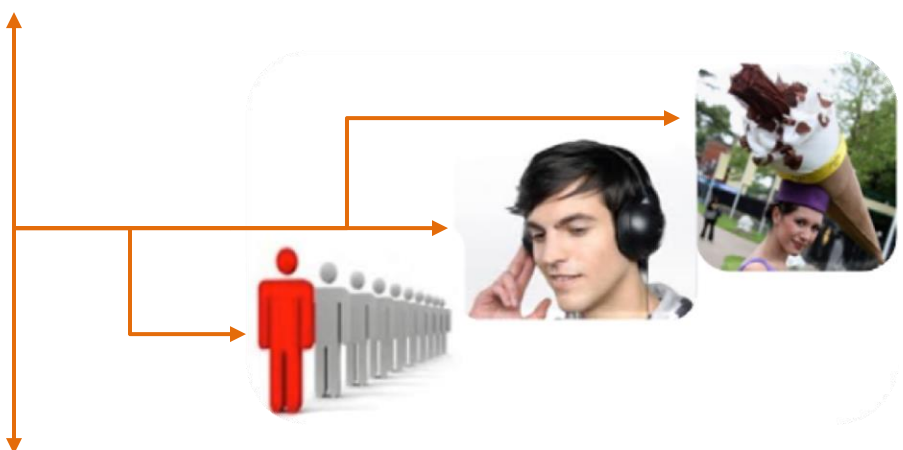

- There will be after school buses to take you home.

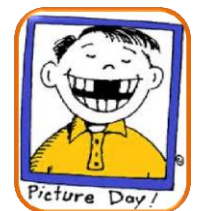


Student Council Meeting: Nov. 9
