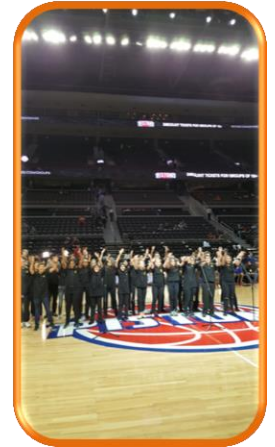

### Stout Annual Canned/Boxed Food Drive: Nov. 28 – Dec. 14

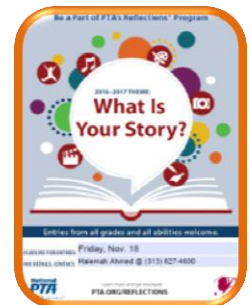
