- Please see Coach Haddad in room F4 for a physical form if you have not participated in a sport this school year.

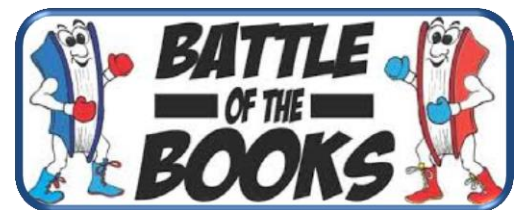


Girls' Swimming Team wins 105 – 69
