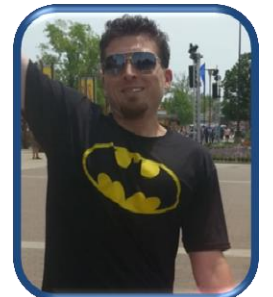


**"Save it or Shave it" is Back!**
